St. Paul's New Cook Put His Chopping Knife Into Bourke Family.

APOSTLES EAT THREE STRAIGHT MEALS

ST. PAUL, Minn., Aug. 15.—(Special Telegram)—Herman's Red Caps made it three straight with Omaha for the second time this season by winning the final game today. In addition to being the final game of the present series this was the last game of the season between the two teams, and in winning it the Salts captured the season's series by the margin of 1 to 0.

Cook, the young St. Paul amateur who joined the Order of the Red Cap last week, was pitted against Herman, and beat the Wizard out, although it was a tight squeeze. Both twirlers were given knock support, but the Red Caps were lucky in working their best plays into innings in which no runs were made, while Bourke's men bunched all their errors with four hits in the first two innings, and five runs, all that St. Paul made, resulted with but one earned. Cook was a trifle unsteady at times, but it was generally when the bars were unoccupied. At times hundreds were standing or sitting on the upper railings and in the aisles. Fully 15,000 of the exposition crowd witnessed the races.
