## WATCH ANARCHISTS CLOSELY

Desperate Characters Abroad Are Kept Under Close Surveillance

Since Buffalo Crime.

LONDON, Sept. 28.—(New York World Cablegram — Special Telegram.) — Meyer Pole, a desperate character who recently left here for New York, a bootmaker by trade, is said to be a friend of Czolgosz and knows Emma Goldman's brother, who is employed as a capmaker in Aldgate. He has served fourteen years for forging Rus-sian banknotes and five years in Switzer-

land for forging letters of credit. In consequence of Emma Goldman's noto-riety German detectives in London are pay-ing especial attention to two groups of anarchists with whom she associated and who have headquarters on Broad street, Soho. They are suspected of complicity in a plot to assassinate the kaiser.

The Caliau anarchists who meet in the Cafe Saffronhall are much concerned at the disappearance of one of their number, An-tonio Buoli, who, armed with a revolver set out with the express intention of attempting to kill the czar while the latter priced dentistry in Omaha. Es-tablished in 1888 We de ravisit to France. Buoli's mission was disclosed to the police by a foreign newspaper correspondent, who was trusted by the Ital-ian section. Buoli was arrested in Compeigne and has not been heard of since His companions fear that he has been quietly transported to New Caledonia. They are deeply concerned at his gaining ne notoriety. Soveral other members of the same group left London afterward for the continent.
