JIMMY MANNING OUT OF WASHINGTON

Tom Loftus Takes Management of Capital Team and Frank Selee Comes West from Boston to Take Chicago Remnants.

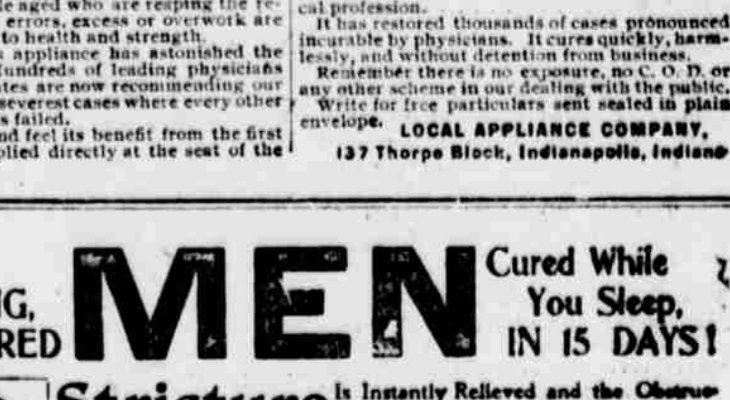
