"Yes, the question of the successor to Mr. Anderson as cashier of the Omaha National probably will be decided before I return to Washington, but nothing decisive in the matter has been done yet."

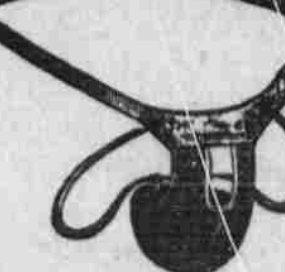
