Third Game at Colorado Springs Interesting From the Millionaire Standpoint.

ROURKEITES BETTER AT BAT THAN FIELD

Four Errors and Twice as Many Bases on Balls With One Batter Hit.

Tells Story of the Defeat.

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo., June 19.—(Special Telegram.)—The best and most exciting game of the series between Omaha and Colorado Springs was witnessed today by about 1,200 people. It was anybody's game until the last inning when it was in the last inning. Both pitchers were hit rather freely, but Neumeier was more steady at critical points and received somewhat better support. The feature of the game was Hemphill's three-bagger to deep center, scoring Granville, and a moment later scoring himself on a long fly by Everett to Genies, who was unable to return the ball to the plate in time.
