

AWAY TO FACE THE HOODOO

Omaha Team Starts Its Final Visit to Mountain Town.

PAPA BILL HOPEFUL OF BREAKING SPELL

Firm in His Belief that Experience of Former Trip to Colorado Will Not Be Repeated This Time.

Manager Bourke and a base ball team of fourteen left at 1:30 p. m. yesterday for Colorado over the Rock Island, to face a series of games which is the critical feature of the season's schedule for Omaha.

There is one change in the Omaha team for this trip. Ed Hickey's throwing arm has not yet recovered from the wrench it received in the first game of the second double-header with Colorado Springs here on August 26, so he will be left at home.

As a timely substitute comes Hille Pete Borg, whom Bourke secured again from Joe Quinn on Monday on the arrival of "Ducky" Holmes to join the Des Moines team.

Burg will play third on the west-ern trip. There are no other changes.

Despite the unenviable experiences that the Rangers have had in Colorado every trip so far this season Manager Bourke does not despair. Said he:

"I realize that everyone thinks this trip is to be a body blow to us, but we may do something out there after all. It is time that hoodoo is broken. Things cannot always run the same way, and while Denver and Colorado Springs have certainly been as plenty so far, we can fully repay ourselves for all that we have taken in by taking a good proportion of these coming seven games."

What is Left at Home.

The team will reach Omaha again on Wednesday morning, September 10, with just thirteen days of base ball remaining for it. For those thirteen days eighteen games yet unplayed confront the boys.

A separate effort will be made to play them all off, and with good weather this can be done. That means double-headers galore with Peoria, Milwaukee and St. Joseph, the teams that are carrying the extra games Omaha needs.

The season closes tonight on September 22, so every game that is to count must be in by that time.

First comes Milwaukee, playing here on September 19, 21 and 22, three games only. Then the St. Joseph team will arrive, being dated for September 13, 14 and 15.

With this team, however, there are five games to be played, and it looks like two double-headers with the Saints.

Next is an open day, September 18, with Peoria booked for September 17, 18 and 19.

There are six games to be played with that team and Peoria and Omaha will certainly need that open day if Peoria can come over to time to utilize it. Otherwise St. Joseph may stay over and take it.

Last is Milwaukee, assigned to September 20, 21 and 22. There are four unplayed games with this team. This completes the schedule for about as strenuous a finish as could be imagined. The members of the Omaha team will certainly get plenty of the national sport in that last two weeks at home.

TWO HORSES AND DRIVERS GO DOWN

HARTFORD, Conn., Sept. 2.—Ansell trotted two slow heats in the Charter Oak \$10,000 event today and then went in and won three straight heats.

The race was marred by a bad accident in the first heat when Idolita and Haw-tonica came together, both going down. The accident happened at the three-quarter pole and the majority of the 5,000 spectators left the stands, crossing the infield to the scene of the accident.

The horses and drivers were found to be uninjured. Each driver blamed the other, but it was found that Driver Teaser fouled the wheel guard of Hudson's sulky, Idolita had won two heats and had a good position. The first heat Ansell broke at the start and again in the back stretch. Metallas gave Idolita a hard drive and Ozanan broke badly. In the second heat Metallas led to the back stretch, but Idolita took the heat. The third heat was easy for Ansell, with Ozanan coming fast and getting second place. The fourth heat looked good for Haw-tonica, but he broke at the wire, and though Ansell had broken twice, she came in a winner. The fifth heat was an easy win for the favorite.

The pool sellers evidently feared Direct Hal's bursts of speed and no pools were sold on the favorite for the 2:30 race. He won in straight heats, and although the time he made was fast, he could have done better. Greenline sold for second place at even money. To win the third heat and race Direct Hal had to pace the last quarter in better time than the Greenline, who led at the three-quarters pole, though the quarter in :30 1/2, and Direct Hal was two lengths behind Greenline when time was snapped at the stretch mark.

Eulale sold favorite in the 2:16 trot. He won the first heat, but was out of the race when he was taken out by Silver Fox. Hal Fry continually broke in scoring, but in the third heat he went remarkably fast, and it was by the hardest driving and in a whipping finish that Hudson took the heat with Silver Fox.
