Price Raisers Molested. A bill was introduced today by Representative Bell (Colo.) providing that any producer, dealer, transporter or agent who shall join with any other person or persons in a conspiracy to raise the price of any article of food or fuel, or its carrier, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$10,000.

SHOOTS THROUGH WINDOW Assasin Murders Missouri Lumberman as He Sits Reading Paper.

CHARLESTON, Mo., Jan. 17.—J. W. Bower, a wealthy sawmill owner of Anliston, six miles south of here, was assassinated last night by some unknown person while he sat reading a paper in his room.
