CONVICTED OF CONSPIRACY

Brass Moulders of Chicago Found Guilty of Intimidating Non-union Men.

CHICAGO, Jan. 24.—Four of the brass moulders on trial for conspiracy to injure nonunion men during the troubles of 1902 were found guilty today.

They are Jacob C. Johnson, W. H. Ganon, both of whom were sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,250, Gus Hoyle and Thomas Christy, fined \$150 each.

The six men were members of a local brass moulders' union and constituted a secret executive committee, alleged to have been appointed for the purpose of employing a band of men to slug and otherwise injure certain nonunion men who were pointed out by pickets.

As a result two men were shot and several beaten severely.
