The church has in its treasury about \$3,000, and an equity of probably \$2,000 in the present building on Park avenue, giving a working capital of about \$5,000, and It is thought that the additional \$40,000 which the church is expegted to cost can easily be raised by subscription among the members, as the church has thereased its membership largely in the last few months.


