Chicago, March 13.—There was a repetition of yesterday's dullness in the grain pits today and with the exception of oats prices ruled easier. May wheat closing 4 1/2 c lower and corn a shade lower, but oats were 1/2 c higher. Provisions closed steady.

Beef Steers Rather Slow and Weak, but Cows Held About Steady. HOGS SOLD FIVE TO TEN CENTS LOWER

Receipts of Sheep and Lambs Rather Light and as Demand Continued Good the Market Held Fully Steady on All Kinds.

SOUTH OMAHA, March 13.—Receipts of Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, Official Monday, 4,414; Tuesday, 5,864; Wednesday, 5,439; Thursday, 4,888; Friday, 4,219.

Five days this week, 21,000; same week before, 20,011; same week before last, 18,496; same week before second, 18,496; same days last year, 16,774.

The following table shows the receipts of cattle, hogs and sheep at South Omaha for the year to date and comparison with last year.

The stocker and feeder market held steady with yesterday on all desirable grades in range of the fact that the end of the week is so close at hand.

Beef Steers—Receipts, 17,000 head; estimated to close about 100,000 head. Hogs—Receipts, 10,000 head; estimated to close about 100,000 head.

Sheep and Lambs—Receipts, 5,000 head; estimated to close about 100,000 head.
