Unless Contractor Partridge Resumes Work Within Three Days.

HOD CARRIERS' STRIKE IS IN THE WAY Building Inspector Orders Contractor

to Proceed, However, or the City Will Finish the Work at His Cost.

Building Inspector Carter yesterday issued an ultimatum to Contractor C. W. Partridge that construction of the Capitol avenue market house must be resumed in three days or he will proceed with the work himself, deducting the cost from the confract price. For two weeks construction has been suspended on account of the hod carriers' strike. According to the inspector there is only about two more days' work for the hod carriers on the building. and then there will be no further necessity for their services. They are striking for to cents an hour, an increase of 21/2 cents, and the entire amount involved in the market house strike is less than \$5. Neither work until the building contractors settle with the hod carriers.

Inspector Carter, who says that immediate completion of the market house is important to the public, called a meeting yesterday of Contractor Partridge, Business Agent Stevenson of the Building Trades Council and three representatives of the hod carriers. He put the matter before them and the contractor said he was willing to grant the raise, providing that the single firm holding out against it, Rocheford & Gould, gives in, but not before. The hod carriers said this meant no work and the building inspector therefore issued his

ultimatum. The inspector said: "If it had not been for the strike the house would be finished now. As it is, the market gardeners are soming in and demanding stalls and none Farnam.

CARTER TO FINISH MARKET are ready for them. The city will spend about \$15,000 on the building and a competing mart is being started. It is no more than right toward the people that the Capitol avenue house be finished as soon as possible. I understand that Contractor Partridge is still trying to patch up some truce with the men.'
