TO MAINTAIN RURAL ROUTES
 Must Be Three Thousand Pieces Handled on Each Every Month.
 FARMERS SHOULD TAKE DAILY PAPERS
 Superintendent Rathbone Suggests that Increase of Circulation of Dailies May Be the Means of Saving Many Routes.

Nothing definite has yet been accomplished by the meeting of the eighteen special field agents of the western division of the rural free delivery service, now assembled here. From some of the observations reported by the agents it looks as if a number of rural routes may have to be abandoned unless the recent order of the Postoffice department requiring that at least 100 families must be patrons of a route to insure its maintenance, and that at least 2,000 pieces of mail must be delivered or received per month. There is no restriction as to the classification of the mail matter.

"It is the decision of the department," said Superintendent Rathbone, "to make the rural free delivery service just as efficient as possible. I resist with the patrons of the routes to secure their permanency. The more mail matter they receive and send, the better for the route. With the present facilities every farmer should take a daily paper; this would help out amazingly in the aggregate. In Indiana the daily papers have very largely increased their circulation by systematically working up the rural mail routes and as a consequence the amount of first class mail matter has also largely increased on these routes. The same thing could be done in Nebraska."

"I do not wish to be understood as detracting to the newspapers as to what they should do, but with them lies a practical solution of the perpetuation of some of the rural routes that must sooner or later be abandoned because of the meager patronage along them. This we do not want to see done, but our orders are imperative and we have no recourse but to obey, unless we can enlist every interest to bring the service up to at least 2,000 pieces delivered or received during the calendar month."
