Wheat Leads Upward March in Board of Trade Grain Prices. PROVISIONS CLOSE DAY IRREGULARLY

Many Causes Conspire to Boost Wheat, Which Rules Strong and Active All Through the Session.

CHICAGO, Aug. 13.—Under the leadership of wheat grain markets ruled strong today, September wheat closing at 1.00 1/2 higher, September corn up a fraction, and oats and rye steady.

There was a big trade in wheat throughout the entire session and the firm feeling was maintained. The market was decidedly strong toward the close, the final figures being at about the best prices of the season.

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On the Produce exchange today the butter market was strong, and the egg market was active. The market for various commodities was generally firm.
