4604 Girl's Apron, 4, 5 and 6 years. Girl's Apron also—Aprons are regarded as necessities by wise and careful mothers and should be included in every little girl's wardrobe. This one is pretty and becoming as well as useful and can be worn over the frock or with the gumps only, as may be preferred. The model is made of lawn with trimming of embroidery, but gingham and all apron materials are equally appropriate. The apron is made with the body pattern and the skirt. The body is shaped by means of shoulder and under-arm seams and is joined to a shallow yoke over which falls the square berth. The skirt is simply straight and full and is joined to the belt which connects it with the waist. The quantity of material required for the medium size is 2 yards 2 inches wide, with 2 1/2 yards of insertion to trim as illustrated. The pattern 4604 is cut in sizes for girls of 4, 5 and 6 years of age.
