ADVOCATES WHIPPING POST

les Day of District Court Suggests that for Recreast Husbands and Fathers.

BECORD SHOWS DIVORCES INCREASING

Eighty-Pive Per Cent of Cor Hundred and Prenty-Six in Omaha Are Applied For by

Judge Day of the district court advocates the old-fashioned whipping post as a rem-edy for divorces and a means of punishing recreant husbands and fathers who desert their pives and children. The marital troubles of the citizens of

The marital troubles of the citizens of Comaha seem to be on the increase if the record of Judge Day's court may be taken as a criterion. Today Judge Day has rounded out a year on the district bench, and during that period he has yearted 126 divorces. In at least 55 per cent of these cases the applications for divorce have been made by the wives. A great per cent of the cases has been instituted on the ground of abandonment. It is thought that the number of cases where the husband has described wife and lables is larger in Omaha than in any other city in the Helted States, according to population. An act of the last legiolature makes ahandonment a pentientary potents. Speaking of this act Judge Day Sald:

Calls it Wise Law. "I think it a very wise provision. The only way to get at these men is to make it a criminal offense for them to abandon wife and home. What we need here is the oid-fashloost watpping post. The admin-istration of physical punishment of some land is the only effective method of reaching a man who has so blusted his susceptibilities that he will go so far as to desert his wife and tables without a mo-

"Various other things have been alieged in these suits for divorce, but the fact that many of them are based on the ground of abandonment is especially noticeable. Other charges have included drunkenthess, uruel and gross treatment, al-teropts at murder and things of that kind." In the upinion of Judge Day the divorce problem is a very grave one and calls for the ablest thought of the day. While the number of divorces in Omaha is large, a currentendingly large increase in the number of divorces is noted in other cities. The question, he insists, is, therefore, of more than local interest, and would seem to demand the carried thought of good people in every section of the country.
