Nervousness is Manifest in Wheat Pit Because of Financial Troubles.

CORN PRICES ARE A SHADE HIGHER

With Little Activity in the Oats Pit the Prices Were Lower at the Close of Dealing.

CHICAGO, Oct. 20.—Wheat prices were nervous again today due to a feeling of uncertainty in the minds of traders as the outcome of the financial troubles in the east, but closing prices were about where they left off yesterday. December wheat was a shade higher, but not over 1/8c, while January provisions closed 1/16c higher. Local traders were inclined to be cautious in their trading early in the day and there was some scattered liquidation, but with reassuring news from the street and on active buying by one or two big bull operators, the market quickly developed a stronger tone. The best support, however, came from the conditions in the northwest and the improved export business. Duluth reported 100,000 bushels taken there for shipment, and reports from Minneapolis said that country millers were buying wheat there, December was in active demand and advanced 1/8c. At this point there was considerable profit taking and the session was inclined to weakness. December wheat was higher at 1 1/2c, while January wheat was 1 1/4c. Corn was 1 1/2c, and soybeans were 1 1/4c. Oats were 1 1/4c, and rye was 1 1/4c. The market was generally quiet, with some scattered activity in the afternoon.
