Each Team Has Now a Chance for the Championship of the Big Nine for the Year.

One week ago six foot ball teams representing all that was best in western football met in annual contest in three games, which because of their intrinsic importance and the vital influence they exercise on the ultimate outcome of the campaign for the western championship, were deemed by many to be the most important day for western football, with the possible exception of the best contests which are scheduled for Thanksgiving.

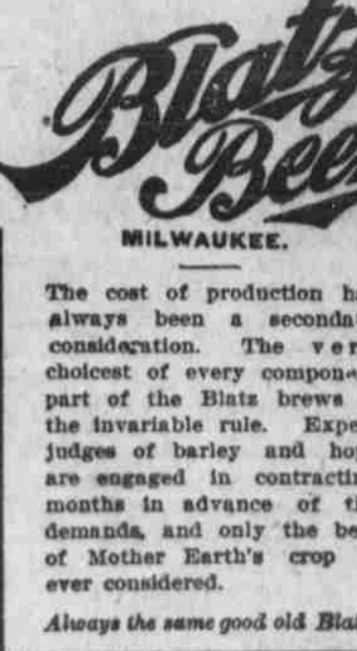
