(From a Staff Correspondent.) DES MOINES, Nov. 7.—(Special.)—The State Agricultural Institute in connection with the annual meeting of the Iowa Department of Agriculture will be held in Des Moines December 7-9, and an unusually fine program has been arranged for this meeting.
