ATTORNEY BYRD STAYS AWAY

Floyd Byrd, commonwealth attorney of Breathitt county, who gained a reputation as a prosecutor of Curtis Jett and Thomas White for the Marcus murder in a long distance telephone communication to the Associated Press correspondent tonight confirmed the rumor that he has decided to remain away from Breathitt county during the term of court which begins at Jackson, Ky., tomorrow.

His action is taken upon the insistent solicitations of friends and relatives, who declare that, judging from the past history of the county, his life would be in constant peril there.

Mr. Byrd's term of office will expire on January 1. He will then move to Winchester, Ky., to reside permanently, but does not expect to sever himself entirely from the mountains in which he has been instrumental in bringing about a revolution in favor of the order.
