### ROCK ISLAND CUTS THE RATE

Gets Under Stokely Through Grain Tariff to Twin Cities.  
NEBRASKA SCHEDULE NOT REDUCED  
Scheme is Said to Be to Clinch Long Haul Business, and Other Roads May Follow Suit.

The local offices of the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific railway are in receipt of a new tariff which applies on through grain shipments to Minneapolis, St. Paul and the Minnesota transfer. It cuts under that of the Great Western.

When the through proportional rate of 3 cents on wheat and 8 cents on corn to Minneapolis and St. Paul was put into effect by the Chicago Great Western it was made to apply only on shipments which originated in Nebraska which took a rate of 12 cents or over to Omaha on wheat and 13 cents or over on corn. The new tariff of the Rock Island changes this to read 10 cents on wheat and 8 cents on corn, which would make the through rate to Minneapolis and St. Paul 19 cents on wheat and 21 cents on corn.

This rate does not lower either the Nebraska rate or the proportional eastern rate, but serves to bring in a number of shippers on that line to Nebraska which did not profit by the low proportional rate to the east under the old schedule.

After Long Haul.  
The generally accepted theory seems to be that it is the Rock Island's scheme to get the lion's share of through business. The Great Western of course has no line west of Omaha. It is argued that on shipments which originate west of Omaha on the Rock Island for Minnesota points that road would naturally secure the haul through to destination, that is, in cases where the through proportional rates apply, but on local shipments coming into this city, where the rate was too low to secure the through proportional rate, the Chicago Great Western would stand in good chance of securing the business from the east as the road bringing it in, consequently the more shipments which can be brought under the proportional through rate, the more shipments the originating line will be likely to secure to destination, which would be to the detriment of St. Paul.

Government Holds Examination for Additions to Crews in Omaha and South Omaha.

About 100 applicants are filed for the civil service examination for the positions of clerk and carrier in the Omaha and South Omaha postoffices, which began at the federal building yesterday and continues over today. The examinations are conducted in the northwest corner rooms of the building, on the fourth floor.  
An examination will be held in this city on November 23, under the direction of the United States Civil Service commission, for the position of fireman in the postoffice building. Salary, \$728 per year. Age limit, 35 years or over.
