NEW RATE RILES GRAIN MEN
Out by Rock Island Denounced as Plot Against Omaha.

MEMBERS OF EXCHANGE AIR THEIR VIEWS

Declare All Roads Except Great Western Are Combined in Effort to Defeat Grain Market Project.

The members of the new Omaha Grain exchange are very much wrought up over the action of the Rock Island in lowering the rate on grain into Omaha, which is required to secure the low proportional rate on that product out of the city to Minneapolis and St. Paul.

"They see in it a move on the part of the railroad to kill in its infancy the movement to make a grain market here. One grain man explained it by saying: "Don't you see that this brings in a lot of new territory which is enabled to secure the low proportional rate to the east? Before this territory was brought in, the grain shipments from that section would naturally stop in this city, providing there was a market established here, because the grain could not be shipped east under the low proportional rate of 9 cents on wheat and 8 cents on corn, but now that these low rates can be secured east by the shippers of grain from the stations in the new section which has been brought in, the product will, of course, go right by Omaha. It has been my belief all the time that the railroads would do their utmost and try to put a damper on any attempt to build up a market here, and this latest move on their part proves the assertion I have made many times."

Regards it a serious blow.

Another grain dealer said: "I have not noted the new exchange as yet, for the reason that I wished to determine first just how the railroads were going to receive the movement, and now," he said, "I can see, I at first thought perhaps the action of the Chicago Great Western in making a low proportional rate to the east would be a blessing to this city and Nebraska, but, judging from the late action of the Rock Island, I think we have lost all we have gained unless we are smart enough to originate some plan to thwart the scheme on foot. A blind man could see that the new move of the Rock Island will force Stickney to again lower his pro-

portional rate east from Omaha in order that he can secure any of the business, and this, of course, will be met by another reduction by the Rock Island or some other road which runs into Omaha from the west. The ultimate result will be that we will have a flat rate out of this city to the east on wheat of about 9 cents, or less, to Minneapolis and St. Paul, and that is just what the railroads want until this movement is killed. The reduction of the proportional rate by the Chicago Great Western has served us an excuse to the other roads to make a cut. They are all in cahoots, and the next move will perhaps come from some other line besides the Rock Island. When I say that they are all in cahoots I do not wish to be understood that I think the Chicago Great Western is in the deal. I think Mr. Stickney is playing fair with Omaha and doing the best he can for us, and I hope that he will win, which I believe he can if we will give him all the assistance in our power and all pull together against the common enemy."
