WORLD TRANSFER NEGOTIATIONS

ST. PETERSBURG, Jan. 15.—The diplomats here regard favorably the suggestion to transfer the Russo-Japanese negotiations to St. Petersburg. They do not think it is intended to delay matters, as interpreted abroad, but believe it would remove the negotiations from the hands of the war party, represented by Admiral Alexieff, the Russian viceroy in the far east, and enable the czar and Foreign Minister Lansdowne to more closely control them.
