HAWKEYES NOT FOR HEARST

Democrats of Iowa Will Have None of the Katzenjammer Candidate.

CONSERVATIVES STILL DOMINATE PARTY

Bryanism Was Never Rampant in the State of Horace Boies, Despite Endeavors and Activities of Charlie Walsh.

Hawkeye democrats are no more likely to support in the national convention the Katzenjammer candidate than the state is likely to cast its electoral vote for him.

NAVY AT THE WORLD'S FAIR

Show How Men-of-War Are Arranged and Operated in Battle.

ACTUAL LIFE OF MEN TO BE SHOWN

Government is Preparing Exhibit Which Will Give Visitors Correct Idea of Naval Affairs of Nation.

WASHINGTON, March 18.—(New York Herald Service—Special to The Bee.)—The United States navy will be represented at the Louisiana Purchase exposition in the most elaborate way. Indeed, no feature of the government of the United States will have more satisfactory representation.

head of the Olympia, the flagship of Admiral Dewey in the battle of Manila bay May 1, 1898. On the upper or main deck will be installed the sixteen-inch guns, mounted in barbette turrets; a six-pounder Hotchkiss, a one-pounder light automatic, a 30-caliber Colt and a Gatling gun, together with the ship's anchors, windlass and anchor gear complete; also skylights, hatchways, ventilating cowls and slide ladders. On the starboard side will be shown the davits a twenty-four-foot whale boat and on the port side a twenty-foot cutter, and in appropriate places on the deck will be other equipment and ship's fittings.
