Eulls Claim Northwestern Mills Will Get Winter Wheat.

## MUST PREDICT FOR RED RIVER CROP

Foreign Corn Demand to Increase and Many Cargoes Reported—Corn Shortage Is in Trouble.

OMAHA, Dec. 22, 1904.

A shortage in milling wheat which will put many of the winter wheat mills out of business in from four to six weeks and keep others working half time is one of the arguments advanced by the millers of the northwest. The millers claim that the demand for the domestic trade from Kentucky to Texas is so great that the mills are unable to handle the demand and prices about as they want them. The northwest millers are absorbing all the domestic trade and the east is sold to be nearly empty now of winter wheat. The Minneapolis wheat stocks have fallen to 30,000 bushels in five days and it is thought by some to be a question if there is storage capacity there and at Duluth. Carriage prices were manifest Wednesday in the purchase of low grade wheat by mill agents. The demand for the high grade stuff, waterman, the Albany miller who took the wheat on Monday, July 1904, has been credited with having a line now of 1,000,000 bushels. The Minneapolis miller says the four output for last year was 15,000 bushels. The amount was 15,000 bushels for last year. There has been a heavy falling in orders since the first of the month, but the demand is not so great as it was for this season.
