NEW YORK, Jan. 20.—Constraint was manifest on the speculative spirit of the stock market today and the tone was heavy and dull for the greater part of the time. The prevailing weakness, however, of the opening feeling, which came over from the preceding day was soon dissipated. The market was centered largely around Amalgamated Copper owing to disappointment over the dividend declaration. The amount of the distribution was what had been generally expected, but disappointment was felt that the style of the dividend was not made to apply a question as to the maintenance of the rate. The stock was forced down an extreme 1/2c, and without making a recovery which was effectively supported above the low point.
