RAILROAD MEN TO BE HEARD

Senate Committee Makes Engagements for Several Weeks.
NO RATE CURB LAW THIS SESSION
Hearings to Continue During Senate Sessions and Indications Are They Will Occupy Most of Time Before Adjournment.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 21.—(Special Telegram)—Present indications do not give any great hope of serious railroad reform legislation at this session of congress. The introduction of Colonel Hepburn's bill today is along the lines of these dispatches, except that the date of its introduction was postponed by reason of a desire on the part of the attorney general to examine some of its features.

Among the brilliant railroad officials who will be heard next week by Senator Elkins' committee is J. W. Byrbe of Burlington. Just what day he will be asked to appear before the committee is not known, but there are so many railway interests to be heard that the interstate commerce committee of the senate will on Monday ask leave to sit during the sessions of the senate in order that the election of Hepburn bill should ever get any further than the senate committee on interstate commerce.

Norris Bill Misrepresented.
Representative Norris of the Fifth Nebraska district is considerably annoyed over a misapprehension which seems to prevail in his district relative to the bill which he recently introduced extending the tenure of office of congress and members of the senate by the people.

Bryan's Visit to the White House.
William J. Bryan, who has been here for the last two days, called at the White House this morning. Concerning his visit he said this afternoon: "I had a very pleasant talk with the president, in which we discussed many subjects upon which we are in various degrees of agreement."

Omaha Warehouse Fund Increased.
Representative Hitchcock, together with the Indian committee of the house to increase the appropriation for the Omaha Indian warehouse from \$500 to \$10,000, and the committee on the amendment offered by the chairman of the committee when the Indian appropriation bill was under consideration was adopted.

O'NEILL, Neb., Jan. 21.—(Special)—Charles and Bert Miller, two brothers residing in Paddock township of this county, who were accused of cattle stealing, were acquitted this forenoon by a jury of twelve good men and true, after a deliberation of about five hours.
