CONTROL OF THE RAILROADS

President Stickney Points Out Defects in Existing Statutes. GOVERNMENT ALONE CAN REGULATE Big Shippers Get Many Favors Under Present Conditions, but Remedy is in Hands of Congress. WASHINGTON, Feb. 4.—At a meeting of the Washington Economic society last night President A. B. Stickney of the Chicago Great Western railroad was the principal speaker. His theme was "The Defects of the Interstate Commerce Law" and he said among other things:

Thereby preventing all kinds of unjust discriminations. As all the purposes of the law relate to the schedule of rates, and as none of the purposes can be accomplished without a schedule, it is evident that the most serious defect in the law is its failure to authorize the commission to make a schedule of rates. A schedule of definite rates which the shipper would be able to rely upon would be enforceable, because of certainty, while the words of the present law, that all rates shall be reasonable and just, and that every unjust and unreasonable rate is prohibited and declared to be unlawful, are rhetorically grand words but are regarded as void for uncertainty.

Turning now from the defects of the law, I desire to call attention to some extraordinary conditions and influences which have had to be rendered the law unenforceable and which, as long as they exist, will render the most perfect law unenforceable.

Automobile crosses Alps. General Commission Untrammelled. A government commission in making rates would be untrammelled by competition or a desire to secure tonnage for any particular line, and would therefore be able to frame its schedule by square rule, instead of scribe rule. That it does not require high-priced exact knowledge to make a schedule of square rule rates is conclusively proven by the fact that fourteen years ago the railway commission of Iowa, consisting of unskilled men, each drawn on a salary of about \$300 per annum, in a few months time, mostly occupied in framing the protest of the railway companies, made a square rule schedule of rates in Iowa, and in the same year the commission of Illinois, like unskilled men, made a square rule schedule of state rates for that state, and in the same year, practically without change, made a similar schedule of rates for the state of Michigan, covering two great states, having in each other equal area in the world, which are not only satisfactory, but also profitable to more than fourteen consecutive years.
