The firm will open up for business on this side of the river about May 1 For about a year there have been fu-mors that the Council Bluffs grocers would come to Omaha and establish their business here. At that time the Kountzes became interested in the firm and Ben Cotton became a partner. The Stewart house has been in business in Council Bluffs for about thirty years and has always been a conservative firm, enjoying a good business. It has been handleapped by its location from the fact that Council Bluffs does not offer a real grocery snarket. Retailers from western Iowa and from Nebraska who come to the Omaha market, where they have several large grocery jobbing houses to make a complete market, would not cross the river to inspect the house there. For this reason, it is understood,

their business to Nebraska soil. The new grocery house will have the building formerly used by Allen Bros. The building has been reconstructed and the work has been completed but recently It is now thoroughly up-to-date, with electric elevators and other conveniences and accessories, which will make it satisfactory quarters for a grocery house. The Stewarts will have a frontage of fortyfour feet on Jones street and will occupy the entire five floors of the building.
