DUNNE WINS IN CHICAGO

Democratic Ticket Elected at Windy City by About Twenty-Three Thousand.

MUNICIPAL OWNERSHIP PRINCIPAL ISSUE

Defeat of the Republican Candidate Due to Many Causes, Among Which is Personal Revenge.

CHICAGO, April 4.—A political tornado today overwhirled one of the most ruggedly unique localities in the country.

After winning successfully four remarkable biennial fights of independence against the regular republican party organization, John Maynard Harlan, son of Associate Justice Harlan of the supreme court of the United States, was today a loser as a republican candidate for mayor.

Appeals to fear of domination by corporate wealth appeared to sway many voters and perhaps more than any other influence was incorrectly gauged by the republicans.

Calculations upon colored voters were another source of error in republican expectations. An unmistakable defection suddenly manifested itself today in districts where Afro-Americans are numerous and gave a severe jolt to republican campaign managers.

One of the amusing features that tonight is recalled as tending to center good-natured feelings on Dunne's behalf is his record as a father.

The plurality for Dunne, democrat, was estimated at between 22,000 and 25,000 votes.

GENERAL SAKAROFF TALKS

Former Adjutant General Says There Was No Conspiracy Against Kouropatkin.

PRIVATE SOLDIERS EQUAL JAPANESE

PETERSBURG, April 4.—War Minister Sakaroff, in an interview today, declares that the reports of Russia countermanding orders for war material abroad are baseless and grow out of the declination of the foreign officers with which the war effort and the whole nation, and not any one state should join in putting that status up.

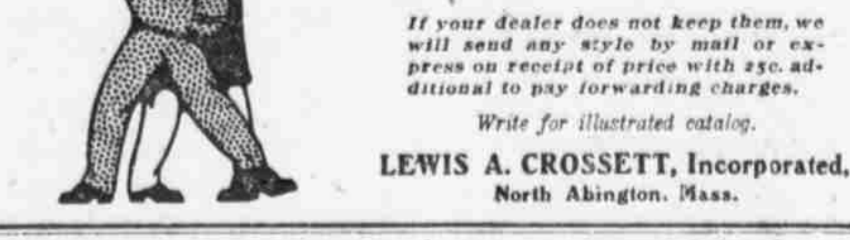
