### LIQUOR FOR THE INDIANS

Brewer Decision Opens Way to Prevent the Customary Prosecution.

STATE ALONE HAS POWER TO REGULATE

Police Power of Federal Government Does Not Extend to Indians Who Have Become Citizens of the United States.

The full text of the decision of the supreme court of the United States in reference to the sale of liquor to Indian allotees of lands has been received at the office of United States District Attorney Baxter from Washington,

The decision grows out of a case coming to the United States supreme court from Kansus, in the matter of an application or a writ of habeas corpus of Albert Heff. who was convicted and sentenced for selling two quarts of beer to a Kickapoo Indian named John Butler. The decision occupies several closely printed pages, which are largely taken up with quotations from the laws bearing upon the sale of liquor to Indians and their civil and tribal status. The gist of the decision is emhodied in these terms, expressed by Justice

Every indian born within the territorial limits of the united States to whom airdinents shari have been made, as hereby declared to be a citizen of the united States and is entitled to all rights, privileges and immunities as such citizen, without in any manner impairing or otherwise arceting the right of any such indian to tribal or other property.

State Has Power to Regulate.

We are of the opinion that when the United States grants the privileges of cities and to an incian it gives to find the benefit of and requires him to be subject to the laws, both civil and criminal, of the shate; it places him outside the reach of ponce regulation or the part of congress; that the emancipation from federal control thus created cannot be set aside at the histories of the government without the consent of the individual indian and state, and this emancipation from redeval control is not affected by the fact that the lands granted to the indian are granted subject of a condition of allemation and encumberance, or the further fact that the lands granted to the indian are granted subject of a condition of allemation and encumberance, or the further fact that it guirrantees to him an interest in tribal or other p. operty.

The district court of Kansas (United States district court) did not have jurisdiction of the offense charged, and therefore the petition is entitled to his discharge from imprisonment.

What May Be Done.

Speaking of the decision, Judge Baxter said: "It is rather sweeping, but still it goes not interfere with the law regarding taking liquor onto the Indian reservations, which is strictly profittied by the federal statutes. There are provisions in the state law which prohibit the sale of liquor to Indians. A measure was introduced in the last legislature to prohibit the sale of liquor within ten miles of any Indian reservation, but it was killed in committee. I be lieve the bill would have passed readily had this decision been known earlier. About the only effective remedy that can be suggested now would be for the state to cede jurisdiction of the reservation to the government, and then the federal authorities could control the matter, just as it controls the sale of liquor and looks after the punishment of crimes on the military reservations. As it is, the state has police risdiction over the Indian reservation now under the Brewer decision. Just what effect the decision will have on the cases now in the federal courts from the Indian reservations will be left to the court to


