

FORT OMAHA BIDS ACTED ON

Contracts for Large Amount of Work Awarded by the Government.

NO OMAHA CONCERN LANDS BUILDING

Conditions of the Contract Require that All Structures Must Be Completed Within Nine or Ten Months.

Major M. Gray Zalkinski, constructing quartermaster United States Army for this point and in charge of the rebuilding of Fort Omaha, received instructions from the quartermaster general of the army at Washington, D. C., Thursday morning approving the award of contracts for buildings, steam heating, electric wiring, etc., to the following named contractors. It will be observed that the aggregate awards exceed \$300,000, or in round numbers \$300,000.

- One set of field officers' quarters... \$ 5,525
One double set of lieutenants' quarters... 14,732
One double set of captains' quarters... 14,900
One double barracks... 45,588

- Total... \$30,990

No Omaha Bidders Win. It will be noticed that no Omaha bidders were successful in landing any of the building contracts, the successful bidders being Webster City, Ia., and Cheyenne parties.

J. J. Hanighan of Omaha secured the contract for heating the new buildings under these last awards for \$15,851, and his previous contract award for plumbing for the same structures at \$16,000, brings the Hanighan awards up to about \$32,000.

The Wolfe-Lovett Electrical company of Omaha gets a small wiring contract for \$65, and the Nebraska Electric company of Omaha a wiring contract for \$3,290. The aggregate amount of awards coming to Omaha being \$55,906 out of the \$300,000.

The conditions of the awards require that the buildings must be completed within nine and ten months from this time.
