Black Rust Reports from Northwest: Tends to a High Rate.

WHEAT TAKES JUMP OF THREE CENTS

September Grain Nearly Six Cents Above Where July Started Monday—Increase in Foreign Demand Helps Corn Along.

OMAHA, July 21, 1933. The bears had a busy time denying reports from the northwest, for they cause thick and fast. The effect was to boost the market until at one time September wheat was \$3 above its Monday price and the May-Monday price had reached its high point at \$4 above yesterday's September. The market closed at 93 1/2 and 94 1/2, and December at 92 1/2.

Reports came from Hillsboro, N. D., that black rust is showing up there ten days ahead of last year. Jones and Ingalls of Minneapolis, Minn., report that black rust may be very probable. Heavy rains hang over Manitoba and the hills in this weather is ideal for development of rust. Fringle, Elch & Rankin at Minneapolis report that black rust is showing up there, but that it is not yet admitted the truth of reports yesterday, are fully convinced.

Today's Ocean news, quoting a northwestern elevator man, "I cannot discover any reason to be alarmed just now by a few isolated cases of black rust which have been found. But I guess if you went out into the fields with a microscope and a microscope camera they are doing and you could find as much damage any year. Our reports this morning are satisfactory and weather looks good for development of rust.
