A. Elmer Turner, educational and religious secretary, will leave September 1 to become general secretary at the City of Mexico. The present secretary there, George I. Babcock, who went from Omaha three years ago, will become national secretary of Mexico. Besides having the duties of secretary at the Mexican capital, Mr. Turner will be expected to develop association work at neighboring cities. E. F. Denison will take charge of the educational work here and W. S. Rothery of the religious work.

Arthur Jorgenson, present financial secretary, will leave early in September for Lincoln, to become student secretary at the State university. His place here has been offered to H. A. Stone.

John Hay Kuhns will go to Japan to teach English in the government schools of that country. Mr. Kuhns left Wednesday for San Francisco. He will meet an educational committee representing the Japanese government when he gets to Sidsun, and a station will be assigned him. Mr. Kuhns was sent out by the international committee of the association and will be expected to engage in association work when not actively employed in teaching English.

One or two men each year have gone from the Omaha association to foreign fields. Three years ago Mr. Babcock went to Mexico, two years ago W. W. Lockwood went to Shanghal, China, and last year D. Burr Jones went as army secretary to the
