Jobbers Eay the Season is Satisfactory with Them.

WEEK'S BUSINESS BEATS LAST YEAR

There is Prospect of Higher Prices in Sugar-Spot Coffee Slightly Lower-Shoe Saleamen

Are on the Road.

Jobbers report business for the week as having a bigger volume than the corresponding week of last year. The dry goods men are still very busy and the grocers are doing a big trade. Fall trade is opening up rapidly with the shoe and hardware people. The main feature of the market is the slight easiness in coffee and the prospects for an increase in the price. ware people. The main feature of the market is the slight easiness in coffee and the prospects for an increase in the price of sugar early next month.

Salesmen are on the road now for the shoe houses and they report a good business. Leather is firm. The hide market shows no weakness whatever, except in heavy weight sole leather stock. All raw material for use in upper leather, including light hides and calfskins, are firm with attempted advance, which buyers stoutly resist. Receipts of cattle at slaughtering points are increasing with a corresponding increase in the hide take off, but there seems to be no corresponding ease in the price of hides, and while the imports of hides from South America show increase over last year, they are still below the imports of 1963. The markets of the world are higher and everything points to a continued high market throughout the fall and winter.

Just now the market is a little up on coffee options, but spot goods are the easier. Yet there is not enough decline to warrant heavy buying by the wholesalers, even considering the fact that freight rates on coffee and sugar are scheduled to advance. Receipts of Rio and Bantos are from 40,000 to 50,000 bags less each week than a year ago.

Sugars, both raw and refined, remain unchanged. The demand is heavy. Rates were adjusted satisfactorily by the railroads concerned at a meeting last week. The new schedule will not go into effect until October 7. It will advance prices at Missouri river points 24c a hundred pounds. Cheese holds about the same price. There is a good demand for this article.

There is a strong undertone in the rice market and business is fairly active. A few parcels of the new crop have been received on the Atlantic coast and enlarged offerings are expected during the week. The market at New Orleans is strong and active. Raugh rice is held at higher prices. Japan rice is slightly easier. Continued improvement is shown in the demand for molasses as cool weather advances. Prices are practically unchanged. The market is about the same on fish. Holland herring has settled to a steady basis and lower prices are not expected. Sait mackerel is a little firmer.

Olives are advancing rapidly in price this year's goods being up 15c to 25c advances are very scarce, and it is predicted there will be no decline this season. Goodszee and 25c a galon on bulk. Certain sizes are exceedingly hard to obtain.
