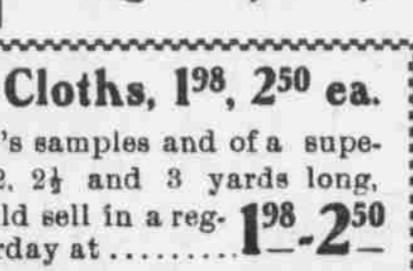

Pasture Lands for Lease

IN SOUTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA

The Interior Department of the United States will lease, for agricultural purposes, the Indian pasture lands of Oklahoma. 100,000 acres of some of the best agricultural land in Oklahoma, located in CADDO, KIOWA and COMANCHE counties.

Terms are reasonable, length of lease fixed at five years from January 1, 1906, with the lessee's preference right to re-lease them, subject to appraisal by Secretary of the Interior. Amount of land to be leased to any one person, firm or company is from a quarter to two sections.
