NASH AND MERCHANT TALK

Milwaukee General Agent Says His Road Did Not Disturb Situation. EXPLAINS WHAT THE CONDITION IS. Grain Exchange Secretary Makes Reply to Statement Which Mr. Nash Really Did Not Make in The Bee.

Mrs. Grossman Tells in Letter of Demise of the Doctor and His Funeral. Mourning cards have been received in Omaha, confirming the report in The Bee some weeks ago of the death of Dr. Paul Grossmann of this city at the age of 59, at Soborikow, Germany, October 12, last, during a visit to Europe with his wife in the hope of benefiting his health, and the cremation of his body pursuant to his wishes at Gotha.

DEATH COMES WITHOUT PAIN

Mrs. Grossman passed away without suffering pain and was conscious to the last; that she died peacefully in her own home, holding services in Gotha, at which many great men were present whom he had known during the Franco-Prussian war and by whom he was beloved, not only as a soldier and doctor, but also as a man full of service to his fellow men. Mrs. Grossman was due to leave Hamburg for the United States on Saturday, on the steamship Blucher. Referring to the funeral of Dr. Grossman, the following account is translated from a cutting from a local paper: Chopin's Funeral March, the old war song, "When We Meet Again," accompanied by muffled drums, and the hymn, "Jesus, My Saviour," which was rendered under the direction of Messrs. Boltz-Luckewald's band, were the strains which wended their way from this villa along Dorf street, bearing the remains of a strange man, Prof. Paul Grossmann of Omaha, Neb., under full military honors, he being the proud possessor of the Iron Cross, one of the most distinguished honors bestowed by the German government. Through the great love which never ceases to exist, the strange gentleman visited once more his brother and birth place, and returned to die at an advanced age. About four weeks ago he was carried on a silk pillow, was his brother and his wife and friends could not avert the coming of the end. And now we follow him to his last resting place. On a profusely flower-laden hearse rested the coffin, accompanied by the militia, and before the house in the village, the militia fired three salutes of cannon in his honor and as their last farewell. The procession then wended its way to the grave, where exercises, according to Goethe's, were carried out. Though the remains will never cease to rest in the earth, where he was so well known and loved, his name will long be remembered and spoken of with much reverence and kindness.
