MAY MEAN THIRD BOND VOTE
 Result of Case Testing Legality of Fire Engine Issue Eagerly Watched.

According to City Attorney Breen the validity of using voting machines is not really questioned in the case brought by Attorney A. G. Ellike to test the legality of a proposed issue of \$60,000 fire engine house bonds. As a matter of fact the suit is a friendly one and originated in the city legal department because the proposition called for bonds both for buying a site and building a station in the Fifth ward.

The charter authorizes the city to issue bonds, properly voted by the people, for the purpose of constructing fire engine houses, but says nothing about the use of money derived in this way for the purchase of sites. Of the total bond issue of \$60,000 \$40,000 was called for for simply building the house at Twenty-fourth and Cumings

streets, but the remaining \$20,000 was requested by ordinance and in the proclamation both for building the Fifth ward house and getting a lot to place it on.
 The discrepancy was noted by the attorneys for Brandeis & Sons, who bought the bonds, and after discussion it was decided to get a court ruling on the point in order to safeguard all interests.
 The real point at issue is whether the city has any right to issue bonds or use money from bonds for buying real estate. It is contended there is no authority for issuing, selling or using the proceeds of bonds for doing aught with fire engine houses, but paying for the cost of construction.
 It would not surprise the legal department to have the courts take this view. In case the decision is that way it means submission again to the voters at the spring election, or for the third time, and considerable delay in the erection of the buildings.
