

FORTY DAYS OF SELF-DENIAL

Lent Begins Wednesday, Season Culminating with Easter Sunday, April 8. OBSERVED WITH CUSTOMARY DEVOTION

Catholics Will Hold Special Services Wednesdays and Fridays and Episcopalians Have Their Particular Exercises Outlined.

Wednesday is the beginning of Lent. For forty days from that date, or until April 8, which is Easter Sunday, all good Catholics and Episcopalians, and many people of other denominations as well, will devote themselves to acts of self-denial and to special works of religion and charity.

For the guidance of Catholics during the season a letter of Bishop Schallmeier, and the "Spirit of Lent" is read in all the churches last Sunday. Besides telling the church members how they should devote themselves to prayer and to acts of charity the bishop mentioned some of the things which they should not do.

At the Episcopal Churches. Lenten services at the Episcopal churches will be as follows: St. John's—Ash Wednesday evening, conference by Rev. Lucius D. Hopkins on "Christian Faith and Practices"; conference each Wednesday evening during Lent; special services during holy week.

All Saints—Services Ash Wednesday at 10:30 and 7:30, every Wednesday and Friday afternoons at 4:15 and every Wednesday evening at 7:30. Trinity Cathedral—Holy communion Ash Wednesday at 7 a. m., and services at 10 a. m. and 7:30 p. m., with sermons by Rev. Percy Silver of Fort Crook; services every afternoon at 4:30; every Wednesday and Friday evening at 7:30.

St. Philip the Deacon—Ash Wednesday, holy communion at 8:30 a. m., prayer, litany and meditation at 10; children's services at 4:15 and evening prayer and sermon at 8; services daily through Lent at 9 and 4:30, except Tuesdays and Fridays, when they will be held at 8.

St. Matthias—On Ash Wednesday holy communion at 7 a. m., morning prayer at 8:30, evening prayer at 4 and 8; every Friday evening holy communion daily at 7, except Saturdays and Sundays; morning prayer daily at 8:30; evening prayer daily at 4; Sundays as usual.

In addition to these services there will be special services every Thursday evening. The first week they will be held at Trinity cathedral.

The clericus of the Episcopal church in Omaha at the weekly meeting Monday arranged for noon services to be held during Lent in the crypt of Trinity cathedral.
