MILLIONS SAVED BY CHILDREN

Money Piled Up by Youngsters Who Were Taught the Habit of Saving. While it is very true that we need postal savings banks, it is also true that it is well to remember that we have a valuable form of thrift teaching in the school savings bank system in a number of our public schools, and that this system, whereby the children's pennies are regularly collected by the teachers in the public schools and placed in the school savings banks, is quietly proving itself one of the best forces extant in training the young to thrift, business methods, happy self-dependence, good habits and good citizenship. It is in some schools in twenty-eight of our cities and our school children have saved over \$2,000,000. Often older people open bank accounts, induced to do so through their children having this opportunity. In Chester, for instance, the officers of the Delaware county savings fund tell me that perhaps 90 per cent of the parents of the scholars who had not earlier been bank depositors have themselves opened accounts, to which they add regularly. If we had had postal savings banks they need not have waited for "a little child to lead them," but would likely have been depositors of savings from their youth up.
