The Canadian Pacific railway still owns a vasi acreage, but is reported to be discouraging wholecale purchases. Both companies have advanced prices a dollar or two an acre, and in some districts the Chindian Pa-cific has withdrawn lands from the market pending a readjustment of prices. The


