

VINSONHALER LOSES CASE

Supreme Court Denies New Trial of Inheritance Tax and Writ.

LESIE MUST APPOINT APPRAISERS Estates Will Be Valued and Taxed and Douglas County Will Get Thousands of Dollars for Improvements.

County Attorney Slabaugh received notice from Lincoln Thursday that the supreme court had denied the motion for a new trial in the inheritance tax case which was appealed from this county.

County Judge Leslie will proceed at once to appoint appraisers in about thirty estates which are subject to taxation and the revenue resulting from the tax will amount to several thousands of dollars.

The law provides a tax of 1 per cent in estates over \$10,000 which descend to lineal descendants, 1 per cent in estates over \$2,000 which descend to other than lineal heirs and 12 per cent on legacies to charity of over \$500.

WATTLES HAS NOT WITHDRAWN
