Several County Conventions This Week. Cummins Has Seventy Per Cent of the Delegates Selected, with Two-Thirds of the State Yet to Hear From.

(From a Staff Correspondent.) DES MOINES, April 29.—(Special.)—The last week has been the most strenuous in the history of the political campaign in this state. The delegates to the convention Guthrie county voting against its home county and Governor Herriott still remaining in the race. Ringgold county, which in 1901 was for Governor Cummins, went for Perkins, and the Tenth congressional district to endorse Secretary Shaw, a resident of the district. As a result of the week's work in conventions and caucuses, twenty counties took political action which either by caucuses, primaries or convention, showed the sentiment of the county and practically in most cases ended the campaign so far as those counties were concerned.
