MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT

Chief Executive Tells Why He Refuses Offers of Foreign Donations.

HAD NO AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT TENDERS

Expresses Thanks for Sympathy of World for San Francisco and States Position of the Government.

WASHINGTON, May 3.—A special message was sent to congress by President Roosevelt in which he explained the attitude of this government regarding the offer of contributions to the San Francisco fire and earthquake sufferers from foreign countries.

Text of Message. The text of the message is in part as follows: "To the Senate and the House of Representatives: Immediately after the disaster at San Francisco many offers of assistance in the shape of contributions were tendered by foreign individuals, corporations, governments and municipalities."

Thankful for Aid. Where these proffers of aid are made to the government relief committees, organized to deal with the distress in San Francisco, I have no official action to take concerning them.
