RECEPTION FOR VETERANS

W. B. G. Acts as Host for Opening Function of G. A. R. Encampment.

COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF TANNER PRESENT

Members of the G. A. R. Busy Laying the Lines for Favorite Candidates for Officers During the Coming Year.

LINCOLN, May 16.—(Special Telegram.)—

With Commander-in-Chief James Tanner and National President Mrs. Abbie A. Adams of the Woman's Relief Corps as the guests of honor, the Veterans Relief Corps gave a reception tonight to the members of the Grand Army of the Republic who are here to attend their thirtieth annual encampment. The reception was held in the Auditorium and the large building was crowded many having to stand. Upon the stage with Minnie B. Bell, who presided as chairman, were the department officers, Governor Mickey and members of his staff and many others prominent in the affairs of the city and state. The Auditorium was tastefully decorated and pictures of Lincoln, Grant, Sherman and Thayer were shown.

Acting Mayor Raymond, Councilman

Frankton welcomed the old soldiers and the reception started off with a rousing cheer, which was repeated at frequent intervals during the evening. Governor Mickey responded on behalf of the soldiers and then

Corporal Tanner spoke. His address was a eulogy of the Woman's Relief Corps and those who fought for its existence, winding up with a plea for woman suffrage.

President Abbie A. Adams spoke equally as eloquent for the good work Corporal

Tanner had done to make the Woman's Relief Corps possible. Brief addresses were

delivered by Department Commander Lett and Department President Harriet Wilcox.

The bugle call was given by O. C. Bell to the evident satisfaction of the old veterans. During the evening vocal selections

were rendered by Clemens Mowius and Mrs. M. D. Hoover. The invocation was by

Rev. Harmon Bros, former department commander.

Corporal and Mrs. Tanner, together with

Mrs. Adams and a number of veterans, reached the city this afternoon and were met at the Burlington station by a large

crowd of citizens and members of the Grand Army of the Republic, headed by

Governor Mickey.

G. A. R. Politics Active.

The old soldiers and members of the

Woman's Relief Corps began to arrive yesterday and last night the hotels and the

streets were thronged with them. For some reason the business men have failed to get

out flags and bunting and the residences are not adorned with the national colors.

In some of the show windows, however, guns and cannon and relics of the war days

are on exhibition.

The members of the Grand Army of the

Republic were busy with the politics of their organization last night and candidates

for officers were being tried to make combinations. Among those prominently

mentioned for the position of department commander are General J. D. Gage of Lincoln,

John Maxon of Minden, J. B. Barnes of Grand Island, P. C. Johnson, chaplain

of the state penitentiary, and H. W. George of Broken Bow. Considerable sentiment

has been expressed against promoting the senior and vice commanders to the highest

place and this may not be done this year.

Yesterday General Culver took a crowd

of the veterans to Millard to show them what is needed at the Soldiers' Home at that place.

The council of administration, met this

afternoon and allowed a number of bills. Among these bills was one for \$100 which

was for the gold badge to be given Department Commander Lett. This is the first

time on record a badge has been ready to deliver when the officer retired; heretofore

having been presented the year before. This year the council has had three meetings,

but for the first time on record its members have not charged up any expense

for the meetings.

hear the Kennard saloon case, when the Blair case will be brought before him.
