## HITCHCOCK FIGHTING BRYAN

Charged by Democrats with Trying to Block His Presidential Boom.

AUTHOR OF THE TIBBLES INTERVIEW

Owner of Indicator, Populist Organ, Published from World-Herald Office and Inspiration of Its Utterances.

Gilbert M. Hitchcock, editor of the World-Herald and candidate for the senate and congress, as the case may be, while pretending to support William Jennings Bryan through the columns of his paper, is charged by some of his democratic brethren with plotting a conspiracy calculated to defeat Bryan for the presidency.

"Thomas H. Tibbles, late candidate for vice president on the populist ticket, recently gave out an interview to the Associated Press, saying a movement was on among the populists to put a separate ticket in the field should Bryan get the democratic nomination," said a leading democratic. "That interview came, not from Mr. Tibbles, but from Mr. Hitchcock. It was another of Mr. Hitchcock's secret blows, and Tibbles was simply his mouthpiece. Tibbles, you know, is the editor of the Indicator published in the World-Herald office and bearing the imprint of the World Publishing company. Isn't that enough?"

"Hitchcock cannot forget the 'ring of ingratitude,' as he chose to term Mr. Bryan's action in urging Governor Poynter to appoint a tried and true statesman, W. V. Allen, instead of Hitchcock, as an aspiring politician, to the vacant seat in the United States senate."

**Janus-Faced Editor.**  
"In the World-Herald Hitchcock appears to be for Bryan and occasionally publishes an article favorable to his candidacy for the presidency. But he turns right around and has Tibbles publish in Hitchcock's Indicator an attack on Bryan. Hitchcock stands sponsor for the indicator. He controls it absolutely and he is responsible for the interview given out by

Tibbles. Hitchcock may think he is playing a mighty smooth game. He is trying to make the democrats of Omaha think he is for Bryan in order to get Bryan strength in his race for the senate or for congress, while at the same time through the indicator he is doing all he can to stir up opposition to Bryan. Tibbles is merely the mouthpiece for Hitchcock, and there are enough democrats who know this to make mighty hard sledding for Hitchcock. Two years ago he opposed Bryan and tried to prevent a Bryan delegation from going to the national convention, and now, through Tibbles and the Indicator, he is trying to create a sentiment against Bryan.

I know positively that Tibbles is on the Hitchcock pay roll and he gets his checks just like the other employees of the World-Herald. Hitchcock is opposed to Bryan, but in the World-Herald he cannot come out and say so, but he can have his employee, Tibbles, do the talking. It is not generally known among democrats that Tibbles is really employed by Hitchcock, but such is the case, nevertheless."
