Information is Given by County Officials to Govern the Primaries.

Instructions to voters at the coming primary election have been prepared by County Attorney Shabugh, Deputy Foster and County Clerk Haverly, touching points on which questions may arise on primary day.

Any voter who declares under oath to a judge of the primary election that he cannot read the English language or that by blindness or any other physical disability he is unable to make up the ballot upon request receive the assistance in the marking thereof of one judge and one clerk of the primary election officers.
