**BURLINGTON CUT NOT MET**

Reduction in Grain Rate is Unapproached as Yet by Competitors.

**MISSOURI PACIFIC TACKS ON A PROVISIO**

Operating Department Will Pay Half Cent for Movement at Time of Service and Not on Elevator Grain.

No move has as yet been made by any other road to meet the cut of the Burlington of 1 1/2 cents per hundred on grain from Nebraska points to Omaha. The Union Pacific said it was waiting to see the tariff and if it was as announced there would be nothing else for that road to do but meet the rate.

The Missouri Pacific, which announced a reduction in the rate to southern points of 1 1/2 cents, also talked a proviso on the end of the announcement that "when necessary to make transfer from car to car actual cost for this service with maximum of 1/2 cent per 100 pounds will be absorbed or paid by this company." This is taken to mean that the operating department will pay 1/2 cent for actual movement at the time of service and not on grain which goes into elevators and lays there. On the other hand, it is looked upon as an additional cut in the rate, making the cut on grain to the south 1 1/2 cents—this on the ground that all grain would be transferred or elevated at St. Joseph or some other point.

**Pass Clause of Rate Bill.**

The pass clause in the new rate bill is causing all sorts of trouble. Many classes of individuals who have enjoyed passes have not been included in the list of those entitled to the privileges, and these have been making themselves heard on all sides. Members of the house took the position from the start that the senate had opened up the question of passes and they declined to interfere or to aid in any way in fixing a solution, leaving the matter entirely in the hands of the senate. Members of the house do not regard the prohibitions of the section as very harsh and think the railroads will be able to do about as they please in the matter of issuing free transportation.
