### BIG SHIPMENTS OF GRAIN

Two Million Bushels Expected to Go East on Reduced Rates.

### CAR SHORTAGE MAY HAMPER TRAFFIC

Schedules Now in Effect and Heavy Movement Set in to Continue Until Rates Expire Tenth of August.

What is expected to prove the largest short-time movement of grain in the history of the Omaha Grain exchange began Monday. Members of the exchange estimate that unless prevented by unforeseen circumstances, such as car shortage, Omaha will send about 2,000,000 bushels of grain to the seaboard and Chicago by August 10, after which the cut rates to those points are no longer effective. All the railroads put in effect Monday

morning the rate of 7 cents on corn from the Missouri river to Chicago, and 8 cents on wheat. Wednesday they will make effective an export rate on all grains from the Missouri river, the rate being 18 1/2 cents to Boston and New York and 17 1/2 cents to Philadelphia. One Omaha firm alone expects to ship 20,000 to 25,000 bushels of wheat and already has 25,000 bushels sold. This concern is sending out bids in the country and buying large quantities of grain each day. All buyers reported large acceptances Monday morning. Ninety Cars of New Wheat. Ninety cars of new wheat arrived in Omaha Monday morning, and the movement east began with a shipment of eighty-three cars. For a week of two shipments have been very light, running as low as one car a day, for everybody held grain to take advantage of the rate. Corn receipts are a little larger, aggregating 123 cars for three days, but the main article of shipment will be wheat. From July 30 to August 10, last year, 86,000 bushels of grain were shipped east

without any cut rate. All local firms are making strong bids for grain this year, and they say the movement will be more than double that of the same period last summer. In addition to what is in the country elevators and on the track, a large amount has accumulated in Omaha elevators since the wheat harvest began. General Agent Churchill of the Great Western, who has charge of the independent elevator, has put an extra switch engine at the elevator to handle the cars and says he will run the elevator night and day and expects all the business he can handle. Other roads have not met the Wabash rate on export grain to the Atlantic seaboard, preferring to utilize all their equipment during the rush on Chicago business. The Wabash is better situated for this seaboard rate, as it gets the long haul to Buffalo, while the other roads can haul the grain only to Chicago. Candidates File Names. Fred W. ### AH LIU FIRED THIRD TIME

Chinaman Once More is Ordered Back to that Dear Old Hong Kong.

For the third time Liu Sung, a Chinaman who has lived in Omaha for some years, has been ordered deported back to China. The last order was issued by United States Commissioner Anderson Monday. Liu Sung's attorney, W. F. Wapich, at once appealed the case and Liu Sung was released on \$500 bonds to appear at the next term of the United States district court, in November. It is alleged by the government that Liu Sung, while claiming to have entered the country as a student, has followed the vocation of a laborer and is consequently subject to deportation under the Chinese exclusion acts. Liu Sung is one of the most thoroughly Americanized Chinamen in Omaha. He has taken a course of study at one of the com-

### DRIVER KILLED IN RUNAWAY

Head Injured and Chest Crushed by Wheels of Wagon Passing Over Him.

Gustave Nelson, aged about 35 years, died at 3:15 o'clock Monday evening at the Omaha General hospital from injuries received from being thrown out of a Dietz Lumber company wagon which he was driving at Forty-second and Farnam streets, during the forenoon. His ribs were broken and he also received wounds about the head. Nelson was employed as a teamster by the firm. His horses became frightened throwing him out. One wheel of the wagon passed over his chest. The police were notified and the injured man was removed to the hospital in the police ambulance after being attended by Police Surgeons Harris and Faber. Nelson was unmarried and roomed at 1816 Chicago street. He had relatives living in the city. Coroner Braley took charge of the body.
