Why Stove Putty Makes An Expensive Stove

"If the joints don't fit, daub a little stove putty in 'em."

THE ORDINARY METHOD In the ordinary stove there is an opening of about one-eighth inch between the top and sides. The seams are filled with stove putty, and the parts are bolted together. After a few months' use the putty dries up and falls out, leaving this one-eighth inch crack all around the top, which in an 18-inch stove means seven square inches of leakage. The eight or ten other joints in the stove are fastened together in the same way, so the total air-leakage soon becomes very large.
