Placing of the Stock on a Seven Per Cent Basis Creates a Lively Demand—Close is Strong.

NEW YORK, Nov. 1.—There was a further expansion of business in the stock market today and some gain in animation and moreover the increase of activity was accompanied by a rise in prices. The speculative interest centered largely in Pennsylvania and the whole market was benefited by the call for a dividend on that stock to 7 per cent by the declaration of a semi-annual dividend of the market, compared with 3 per cent for the preceding six months.
